Annual Lions Pancake Breakfast to Benefit Stanton's Non Profit Groups

Stanton, CA April 1, 2012: The Stanton Lions Club has announced that it will use its annual Pancake Breakfast to help other groups in the community raise money. The fundraising opportunity is simple. The Lions will give tickets not for profit community organizations. They can sell the tickets and keep all the proceeds. Each ticket has a \$4.00 value. The Lions will take care of cooking the pancakes, sausage, scrambled eggs, and brewing the coffee.

Each year the Stanton Lions Club hosts a pancake breakfast. Most of the money the Stanton Lions raise goes to their Sight and Hearing Fund. The fund donates money to charities that benefit the visually impaired; and pays for glasses and hearing aids for low income residents of the community. Lion David Parikh explained that "there is a lot of need in our community. We help school children who cannot afford their prescription for glasses. In recent years we have been helping more seniors who need eye care. We also work with the Huntington Beach Lions that have a program to re-condition used hearing aids."

Parikh went on to say, "we decided to open up the fundraiser to other groups in the community. Most work associated with the pancake breakfast involves set up. We can always put more pancakes on the grille, and there are a lot of great people in our community going out of their way to help others. So we thought we would let other groups benefit from the work we put into the Pancake Breakfast."

The pancake breakfast will be on Sunday May 6th at the Boys and Girls Club Gym (11050 Cedar Street, Stanton, CA 90680) which is located next to city hall. The event will run from about 8:30-11:30.
